Ontario Medical First Response Competition

Job Description (Escort)

The Ontario Medical First Response Competition will be **Saturday October 18, 2025 at Grandview Kids Ajax – 1461 Harwood Avenue North, Ajax, Ontario, L1T 0R3.**

As an Escort for this event, you are being asked to be on-site by 8:30am and stay through the end of the competition period of the day, roughly 6:00pm. A Continental Breakfast, a boxed lunch and refreshments will be provided for you during the day of your shift.

Please wear clothing that is comfortable and appropriate to the weather as Escorting duties may require you to regularly be outdoors or indoors. Please wear comfortable footwear and be prepared to walk throughout the day.

Starting at approximately 9:00am, the plan is to have designated Escorts assigned to specific routes to specific scenario sites on the property. You will be trained to use a VHF radio to communicate with our Control Centre. You will be shown your specific route that you will use to bring designated teams from their Team Hold area to a designated Scenario Site. You will remain with those teams during their evaluation at the Scenario site and you will return the teams back to their Team Hold, using a designated route back to the Hold, so as not to compromise the other Scenario sites as your teams may not have experienced the other Scenario sites until later in the day/schedule.

I thank you for your time and support of this important event. Your efforts will help in the training of our medical first responders from across Ontario and in so doing help save lives and reduce the pain and suffering of those injured in accidents.
