As general Volunteer at this event, you will be asked to be on-site for 8:00am through 6:00pm. Meals and refreshments will be provided for you throughout the day. Light refreshments at a reception following the last scenario and cleanup will be provided to all helping us out on the day.

Please wear clothing that is comfortable, appropriate to the weather, and appropriate for the function(s) that you have volunteered for. If it is appropriate for you to wear your St. John Ambulance uniform, you will be notified of this prior to the event.

Some functions, such as a Runner, Escort or Safety, require that you are able to walk distances throughout the day. Should you have any physical disabilities or restrictions that may prevent you from volunteering in such functions, please ensure that you identify these on the Registration Form.

Members of the Health Services Team must hold current professional or first aid qualifications - there is an area on the Registration Form to indicate these.

All volunteer positions require that you are able to take directions and follow instructions accurately. On the morning of the event, you will be briefed on your specific responsibilities by the person in-charge of your area.

I thank you for your time and support of this important event. Your efforts will help in the training of our medical first responders from across Ontario and in so doing help save lives and reduce the pain and suffering of those injured in accidents.
